All classes will perform on June 21st. A dress rehearsal will be in the morning & early afternoon at the Val A Browning Center. The performance is in the evening. Please reserve this day on your calendar! See the dress rehearsal schedule on reverse with the specific times your class/es will rehearse on stage. Some classes are combined with another for recital. Please check to see if your class is marked with an *. If it is their class time will change beginning May 30th to practice with the other class.

RECITAL COSTUME FEE

Costumes will be distributed after June 10th

They will be delivered during class. Costumes on accounts with balances will be held in the office until payment is received in full. Classes will be held until recital. You will need to supply the items below. Don't wait until the last minute...Purchase these items ASAP in the office!

- **Classical Ballet Students** need Pink Ballet Shoes. New tights will be included in your costume.
- **Children's Dance Students** will perform with bare feet except the Children's Dance III Tues 4:00 & Thur 5:30 classes will wear their tap shoes.
- **Jazz/Ballet Students** need black split-sole shoes \$40.00. Tights were charged to your account and will be included in your costume packet.
- **Hip Hop Students** need black split-sole shoes \$40.00.
- **Show-Time Dancers** will need pink ballet shoes and pink tights to wear with their ballet costume

Studio Policy: Accounts must be paid in full, including June tuition, before costumes can be picked up. We have a no refund policy on tuition, costumes and other fees.

A detailed booklet with information on the location, parking, instructions on hair, makeup and other important details will be distributed with costumes.

RECITAL TICKETS

Tickets go on sale through Weber State Ticket office Mon. May 23rd. Tickets are assigned seating \$6.00 each. They are sold on a first come first served basis. You can purchase advance tickets in person at the main ticket box office located at the Dee Events Center, over the phone by calling 801-626-8500 or online at weberstatetickets.com. Tickets purchased online or over the phone require a \$6.00 handling fee. Weber State has a no refund no exchange ticket policy.

RECITAL VIDEO & PICTURES

Individual and class pictures will be taken during dress rehearsal. A professional video of the recital will be recorded. Both pictures and videos will be available to purchase. You are welcome to video or take pictures at the dress rehearsal. We offer pictures & videos for your convenience. You can relax & enjoy the performance, and have something to remember it. No cameras will be allowed during the performance.

To provide a positive environment for the students, we suggest the following for etiquette for audience members:

- Please arrive early and be in your seat before the performance begins.
- Please turn cellular phones off.
- No cameras of any kind will be allowed in the theater during performance. You may video the dress rehearsal.
- Best dress is recommended.
- Please remain seated for the *entire* performance. Leaving early or coming in and out during the performance is inconsiderate to those around you and disruptive.
- Please refrain from calling out or yelling your child's name during the performance.
- Not recommended for children under age 3. If you must bring a young child, please sit near the aisle.
- Many parents bring good luck gifts/flowers for students
