Recital Information 2010

The recital will be held at Weber State University in the Val A. Browning Center Austed Auditorium, on

**Tuesday June 22nd (Cast A) &
Wednesday June 23rd (Cast B)**

The dress rehearsal will be in the morning & afternoon. The performance is in the evening. Please check the schedule for your dress rehearsal and cast assignment. Performance team members will perform both evenings. **Handbooks with detailed information on hair, make up, directions, parking and other details will be sent home with your costume in June.**

RECITAL COSTUMES

Recital costume payments are past due. Please make your payment ASAP if you have not already done so. Recital Costumes will be sent home after June 10th for all accounts that are paid in full including June tuition. If your account has a balance due after June 10th your costume will be available in the office for pickup once your account is paid in full. Accounts with balances over \$100.00 need to be paid with cash or a credit card. Checks will not be accepted on accounts with a balance over \$100.00. We have a no refund policy on tuition, costumes and other fees.

You will need to supply the items below. Don't wait until the last minute...Purchase these items ASAP in the office!

- **Classical Ballet Students** need Pink Ballet Shoes. Tights will be included in your costume. You will perform both evenings but only dress rehearse on June 22nd
- **Children's Dance Students** will perform with bare feet except the Children's Dance III Tues 4:00 & Thur 5:30 classes will wear their tap shoes.
- **Jazz/Ballet Students** need black split-sole shoes \$40.00. Tights were charged to your account and will be included in your costume packet.
- **Hip Hop Students** need black split-sole shoes \$40.00.
- **Show-Time Dancers** will need pink ballet shoes and pink tights to wear with their ballet costume

RECITAL TICKETS

Tickets go on sale through Weber State Ticket office Mon. May 24th. Tickets are assigned seating \$6.00 each. They are sold on a first come first served basis. You can purchase advance tickets in person at the main box office located at the Dee Events Center, online at weberstatetickets.com or over the phone by calling 801-626-8500. Tickets purchased online or over the phone require a \$6.00 handling fee. Weber State has a no refund no exchange ticket policy.

RECITAL ETIQUETTE

Much like a professional opera or ballet, we would like our event to be uplifting and cultural for all involved. To provide a positive environment for the performers and audience members, we suggest the following:

- Please arrive early and be in your seat before the performance begins at 7:00 p.m.
- Please turn all cellular phones and pagers off.
- For the courtesy of others and safety of performers no cameras of any kind will be allowed in the theater during the performance.
- Best dress is recommended.
- Please remain seated for the *entire* the performance. Leaving early or coming in and out during the performance is inconsiderate to those around you and disrupts the performance.
- Please refrain from calling out or yelling your child's name during the performance.
- Not recommended for children under age 3. If you must bring a young child, please purchase tickets near the aisle to allow easy excess to an exit if they become disruptive.
- Many parents bring good luck gifts/flowers for students.

RECITAL VIDEO & PICTURES

Individual and class pictures will be taken during dress rehearsal. A professional 2 camera mix DVD of the recital will be offered from Remember When Films (see details and order form in this flyer.) DVD orders are due June 19th. You are welcome to video and take pictures at the dress rehearsal. We offer pictures & videos for your convenience. You can relax & enjoy the performance, and have something to remember those great moments! No cameras will be allowed during the performance as a courtesy to other audience members and safety for your performer.
